1.RATIONALE

The rationale for school uniform at Cedar IPS is based on the school Mission Statement – everyone equal. Our uniform allows all children identify to as part of the Cedar Integrated School community, maintaining high standards of presentation while also ensuring that our children are comfortable and safe in their uniform and therefore their learning. We also want to reduce the financial burden on our families and any branded items are at a minimum and only provided as an optional choice.

2. SCHOOL UNIFORM

Daily school uniform

Nursery pupils wear:

- Plain navy jogging bottoms
- White polo shirt (with or without logo)
- Navy Cedar sweatshirt with logo

P1-7 Pupils wear:

- Plain navy trousers, shorts, a skirt, or a pinafore
- White polo shirt (with or without school logo) (Navy polo is being phased out)
- Cedar IPS sweatshirt with school logo (teal green for P1-7 and Navy for nursery)
- Plain navy socks / navy tights
- Black shoes – these can be trainer style shoes but should be all black
- A warm coat (preferable with a hood for outdoor learning)
- Summer dresses may also be worn in term 3 of the school year with white socks
- P7 will have the chance to purchase Leavers hoodies in their final year at school

Pupils can choose to wear the school fleece/waterproof coat with school logo

P1-P7 PE uniform

Pupils wear:

- Navy jogging bottoms/leggings/shorts/skorts
- White polo shirt (as above- with or without school logo)
- Trainers
- Cedar IPS sweatshirt with school logo (teal green for P1-7) or plain navy fleece



Pupils can choose to purchase the branded PE items below. However, this is purely an option and no family would be expected to purchase these items.
