



For the attention of all drivers

Please don't park outside the school gates, this causes poor visibility for children crossing and blocks the two-way traffic coming to and from the pitches! Please also ensure that you are not blocking the roundabout when cars are trying to come onto the school site. Do not park on the double yellow lines. Some drivers are unaware that they are causing the traffic to back up. Please show proper consideration for other drivers. If someone else is picking up your child(ren), please explain the traffic system, to save them the embarrassment of other drivers hooting at them or staff approaching them.

If collecting a child from Kilmore Pitches, please **do not block** the lane way to the left and to the right of the gates, as this is causing problems for residents.

The gate is opened each day by Cedar staff, but is sometimes locked again by Council staff and we are not made aware of this. If you find the gate locked, please telephone the school office on 028 44 830009 and a staff member will come and open the gate.
